Tuesday speaker

This week was Bernie Creati from the Soccer Foundation

Bernie Creati introduced our members to Kick Off Geelong, an organisation he set up under the umbrella of the Australian Sports Foundation with a small group of like-minded individuals who saw a need in the local soccer community. Kick Off Geelong aims to provide assistance for junior players (age 5 to 18) facing financial barriers to participation at the Geelong Soccer Club. This assistance comes in the form of registration fees subsidy, assisting with football gear for players, assisting with finances for transportation for players or subsidising activities for the local refugee communities.

Bernie was involved in junior soccer coaching and administrative roles for 11 years whilst his children were involved in the sport, and wants to continue his involvement even though his children are now adults. He is very passionate about the social and health benefits that sport brings to individuals and community, and especially wants give back in whatever way he can to help the young refugee and disadvantaged youth community in the northern suburbs. The biggest challenge is to raise funds to cover the registration fees for children who would otherwise not be able to participate in the sport that they have seen and loved during their childhood.

Bernie was interested in Bayside members’ experience and tips on how his team could tap into fundraising knowledge or learn grant writing skills. Hopefully Bayside may be able to provide some assistance to Bernie in time to come.
