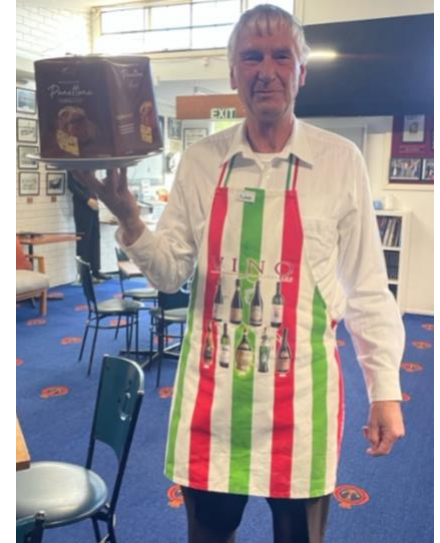

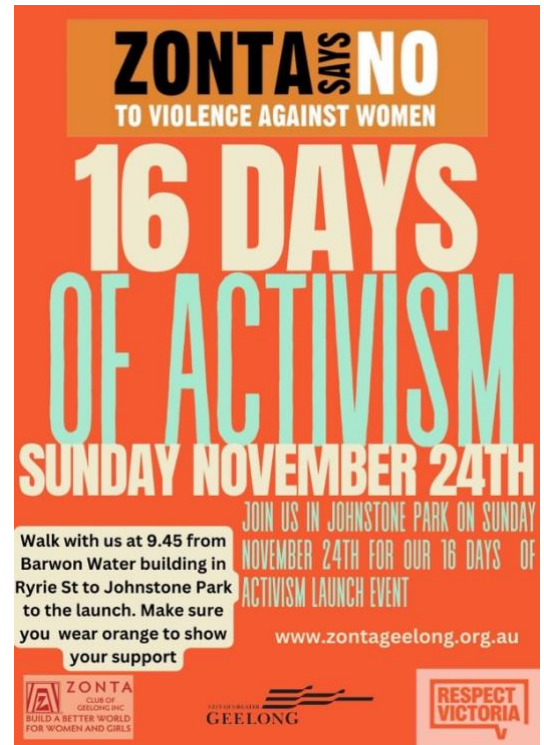
All participants were asked to wear something Orange and suitable walking shoes.
