1. On the Tools menu, click Options.
2. On the Preferences tab, under E-mail, click Junk E-mail.
3. Click the Safe Senders tab.
4. Select the Automatically add people I e-mail to the Safe Senders List check box.
5. Also add [mailservice@clubrunner.ca](mailto:mailservice@clubrunner.ca) and [@clubrunner.email](mailto:@clubrunner.email) to your Safe Senders List

The process for other email platforms will be similar. Please update your Safe Senders
